
Philippians 2:4 "Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others."

Paul authors this Philippian's letter about 60 AD. His concern centered on reaching out to the Christian people in Philippi, Thessalonica, and us for the purpose to describe a Christian life worthy of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our Christian life should be one of joy and thanksgiving. In fact, this letter overflows with joy and thanksgiving. Paul says, "*I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy* (Philippians 1:3-4)." This great apostle adds that joy comes when we are of the same mind and unified in Christ, "*complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind* (Philippians 2:2)."

Paul's point is simply that we can find great joy by being humble and giving as Christ was humble and giving. Our above verse, *""Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others,*" is guiding us to follow the example of Jesus. Our Savior remained obedient to the will of God the Father which means Jesus had to think about us above his self-interested. Self-interest tends to focus on what I want only to ignore others. Watching my grandchildren play is a great joy. But it is easy to observe how self-interest ignores others. One grandchild sees a toy bringing great joy to a sister or brother, so they reach out and take the toy from their brother or sister. As parents we have seen this happen many a times with our rug rats and curtain climbers. The child without his/her toy responds usually with screaming and crying.

Our Savior, Jesus, comes not to take our toys from us. His purpose is to gift us with important blessings which affect us in this world and our eternal future. Paul is encouraging us to follow this example to lift up others! We are to love our neighbor as God loves us! The Christian life style is the style of caring and aiding those in need God through Christ Jesus. Sharing our Christian joy with others brings new joy to us as well.

The Church Council of St. John Evangelical Lutheran Church met for its monthly meeting on January 9, 2023, at 6:00 pm. Council Present Herbert Klatte, Jr., called the meeting to order. Pastor Norm Sulaica opened with scripture and prayer. All current members were present. The December minutes were approved as distributed.

Unfinished Business

Council approved Kenneth Seeker to take the open President-Elect position.

- Sharon Neutzler gave an update on the insurance claim for the lightening strike. Total replacement cost was \$8545.38, less the \$2500.00 deductible, bringing the out of pocket total to \$6045.38.
- Quotes from Brenham Iron Works were discussed for replacing the siding and repairing the gutters on the west wall of the Activity Center. Another bid was discussed to finish the end wall by the BBQ area. **MSC** to accept \$2821.22 for siding and gutter repair plus construction of the end wall \$965.11, for a total of \$3786.33.
