"And he said to him, 'Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."" -Luke 23:43

Jesus was on the receiving end of some bad stuff! Earlier on Friday morning, the religious leaders arrested Jesus. They brought him to the Roman governor to put him trial. The crowd, given the choice to set Jesus or Barabbas free, selected Barabbas. Barabbas the insurrectionist was let go. Jesus, on the other hand, received the death sentence from the crowd, "Crucify him! Crucify him! Crucify him!" And now, Jesus hangs on a cross with one thief to right and another to his left. One thief wants Jesus to free them, while the second recognizes their death sentence is just and confesses Jesus is innocent. He asked the dying Nazarene, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

Does the thief understand who Jesus is? Associating Jesus with the *kingdom* and that Jesus is going to his *kingdom* is confession of recognition. Requesting to *remember me* seeks not to elevate the thief in the eyes of the Messiah. And yet, the thief's humility and confession of belief in Jesus, sets the dying thief on a course to enter God's home, eternally.

The word which jumps out at me is "*paradise*." The Old and New Testament Greek word is " $\pi\alpha\rho\dot{\alpha}\delta\epsilon\iota\sigma\sigma\varsigma$," pronounced *paradeisos*. It is the source word which is the bases for our English word *paradise*. It means to be 'in the garden.' In fact the Genesis 2 and 3 uses " $\pi\alpha\rho\dot{\alpha}\delta\epsilon\iota\sigma\sigma\varsigma$ " for garden, as in Garden of Eden. The image of *paradise* is a beautiful garden setting. What began as *paradise* turned to wickedness and brokenness upon the first couple's actions of eating from the forbidden tree. On that day, *paradise* was no longer our present-day reality.

But now Luke records that reality changes. Jesus tells the repentance thief that he will enter God's Garden, *paradise*. But now, through dying on the altar of the cross, Jesus becomes our sacrificial lamb to pay the price for sin. Jesus dies so that we can live. Jesus breathes his last, so that we can have eternal breath. Jesus' heart stops pumping, so that we can eternally walk with God in His garden.

April is a time Christian's celebrate our beloved God who dies for our sins. We rejoice in the resurrection of Jesus for through him we too will be resurrected. Like the thief, we confess our faith in Jesus and place our lives into His holy care.

Please join the St, John family for Holy Week. We come together to experience and remember God's graciousness through His Son, Jesus. We come with humility to worship our God.




Luther League
