The most googled verse in 2022 is Isaiah 41:10. It reads, "fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Does this fact surprise you that Isaiah 41:10 is the most read Bible verse on the internet in 2022?

2022 is clustered with many challenges for all of us. The Russian Ukraine War begins and many lives are lost and devastated. DEA sees the rise of Fentanyl usage among drug addicts up as well as a rise in deaths from this drug. Our country came out of COVID and looked to rebuilding our economy. Inflation rate rises as high as 7.1%. Food prices are 10.4% higher. Regular gas prices rose 49%, while diesel rose to 55%. In the midst of 2022 being loaded with instability, people turned to God. 2022 left many people seeking help in the midst of hardship.

Through our daily diligence of reading and seeking God's wisdom and guidance, we are given hope and assurance that through our Savior, Jesus, we are blessed from the cross and empty grave. As Jesus makes us right through his death and resurrection, we can live this righteousness with humility by gifting others with the love of Christ. This love can bring light to their tragic and darkened world. Isaiah reminds us our hope is grounded in Jesus and this hope can be shared with those in need of hope.

Please bring the light of our Lord to those you meet each day. Amen.








Church Library
