Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. – Isaiah 43:1

One of the spiritual truths dismissed by the world is the origin of people. Isaiah offers this preface before recording God's spoken words – God "created" us, and God "formed" us! Pause and reflect on these words. Maybe we should sprinkle upon Isaiah's verse God's words spoken in Jeremiah 1:5 – "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you."

Scripture is filled with reality that our presence on earth is not accidental. Someone once shared, "11 million accidents had to happen after the Big Bang theory in order for you to be here." Scripture clarifies, you are not an error, a mistake, a blunder. No way! Scripture is God speaking to us. It illuminates the truth: God planned for you to be here now in Washington County. God planned you to part of St. John Lutheran Church and this special family of faith. You are made by God, called by God, and loved by God! You are a child of God!

With this truth, God says we are not to 'fear' for God 'redeems' you! 'Redeem' means to bring someone to safety! Walking the high school track at 5 a.m. was a daily practice for me! A buddy and I would walk and jog around the track each morning to the tune of 4 miles, 16 laps. The sun was not up, but we were. One morning 10 or so deer saw us walking to the track and took off jumping over the fence. One doe miscalculated and found her back hip wedged between two galvanized poles. Leaving this doe would eventually allow for her to slowly die. This solution was unacceptable. So, we helped her. Covering her head with my shirt, we worked at lifting her backside from between the poles until she was free again. One could say that my buddy and I redeemed the doe's life. We brought her to safety.

God notices the snares and traps in our lives. He could leave us to our captivity. Yet, thanks be to God, he is a compassionate God and filled with mercy. Through Jesus, our captives no longer control us. We are set free through the cross. Jesus unlocks the chains of sin by his blood. He dies so we can live anew in this world, and his death coupled with the resurrection of Jesus brings eternal implications for you and me. We are given also eternal life. This eternal life has no expiration date. It is whole and does not sin. This new body will never erode or die.

So, it right to say 'Thanks be to God for His generous love!' Amen.
