Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

"In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." – Matthew 5:16

Alexander Papaderos, a doctor of philosophy, worked for many years trying to bring peace between the bitterly divided countries of Europe after WWII. His motivation for doing so stems from his childhood and a very odd event which took place. "When I was a small child," he said, "during the war we were poor and lived in a remote village. One day, on the road, I found the broken pieces of a mirror. A German motorcycle had been wrecked in that place.... I kept one, the largest piece.... By scratching it on a stone, I made it round. I began to play with it as a toy and became fascinated by the fact that I could reflect light into dark places where the sun would never shine - in deep holes and crevices and dark closets. It became a game for me to get light into the most inaccessible places I could find. I kept the little mirror, and as I went about my growing up, I would take it out in idle moments and continue the challenge of the game. As I became [mature], I grew to understand that this was a metaphor for what I might do with my life. I came to understand that I am not the light or the source of light. The light [or truth] is there, and it will shine in many dark places only if I reflect it." He concluded: "I am a fragment of a mirror whose whole design and shape I do not know. Nevertheless, with what I have, I can reflect light into the dark places of the world...and change some things in some people. Perhaps others may see and do likewise."

Alexander discovered he could be a reflection of light or darkness. Our Savior, Jesus, encourages us to shine brightly. We are to shine the light of God into all lives around the world. This task is huge for we know we do not have a chance to share the grace of God with *all* people. And yet, we can bear the light of Jesus into the lives of those we meet every day. Words of biblical kindness and deeds reflective of Jesus can bring the gospel light to dark filled lives.

2024 is upon us! Resolves will be determined! Like Alexande Papaderos, let us walk in the light of our Savior Jesus. 2024 is a new year to set our God as our center!


